Our newest slice of Hatteras Hammocks relaxation innovation is kind of like stretching out across an assembly of heavenly clouds, yet with a level of lumbar support once unheard of in a hammock.

Two layers of solution-dyed, all-weather DuraCord® fabric sandwich a plush center of polyester fiberfill batting, with the fabric layers lockstitched together to create lavish interlocking pillows. The patterned cushion reverses to a solid neutral color.

DuraCord, our own branded new-generation synthetic, is resistant to rot, mold, mildew and staining, yet with a softness to rival cotton. Solution-dyed means the color goes into the DuraCord fiber as it's being made, and is effectively sealed inside, becoming a permanent part of the fiber itself. Not surprisingly, DuraCord is the most fade-resistant/colorfast outdoor fabric made today.



Classic Black Stripe

We chose three of our most popular fabrics to launch our exquisite new Pillowtop Hammock style. Our Classic Black Stripe (above), from our Artist line, and Royal Red Stripe (reverse of page), from our Equestrian line, take on a whole different feel atop such blatantly luxurious contours – what was once starkly beautiful is now richly bountiful! Our Rio Birch Stripe fabric (at left), a staple within our Adventurer line, seemed equally perfect for the heightened relaxation adventure promised by this inspired new airborne bed of pillowy plushness.

Hammock spreader bars are South American cumaru, among the hardest, densest, least absorbant, most durable woods on Earth, as well as being among the prettiest. This exotic hardwood's rich hue, ranging from a deep amber to a rich chocolate-brown, but with the faintest hint of cherry-red, reveals upon closer inspection a prominent grain varying frequently in shade, shape and intensity. (All Hatteras Hammocks cumaru is harvested only from managed forests.)
